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Suggestions

Lower level students can use this as an open-book workbook, completed while or shortly after reading each chapter. Intermediate level students can be given the pages as post-reading chapter quizzes to build their memory. Higher level students should not only circle the correct answers, but write them in full grammatical sentences. When the student is finished reading the book, the workbook can be printed again and used as a final exam. As a review activity for classrooms, consider printing this workbook on single-sided sheets of paper and cutting the questions into strips.
